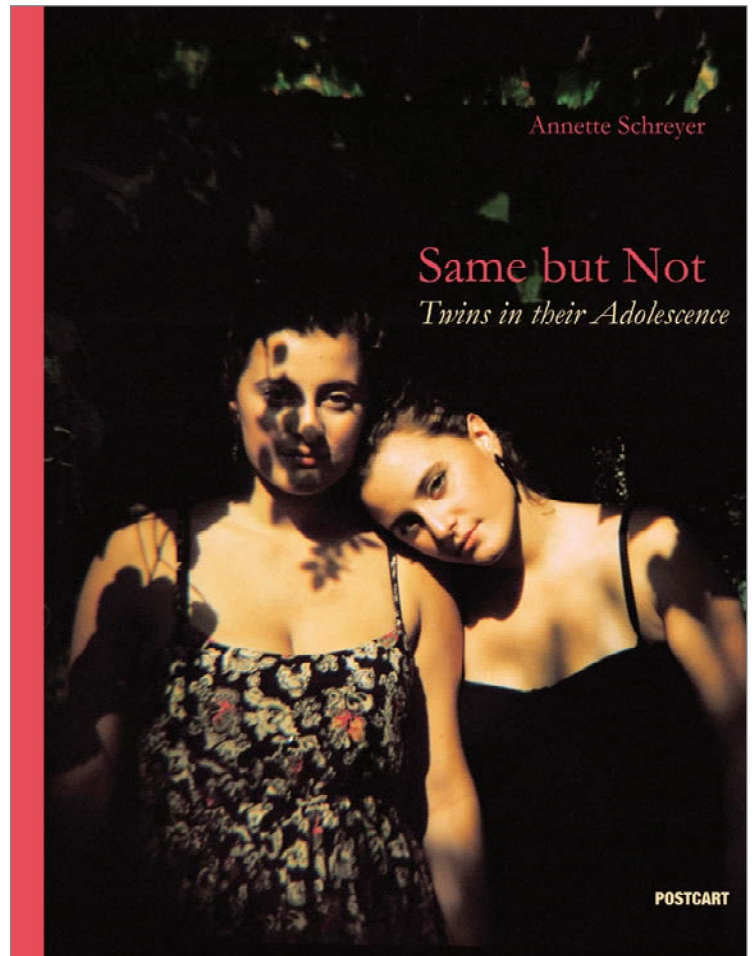
Adolescence is a period where prevails egocentrism and will of self-discovery, but also a desire to face people of the same age.
